ABOUT THE COVER

This new statue of Mary of the Assumption, patroness of the Diocese of Saginaw, stands to the right of the altar in the recently renovated Cathedral of Mary of the Assumption. At Vatican II, the Church made it clear that Mary is not someone Christians should downplay or push to the side. Rather, she is an icon of our own destiny whom we should often gaze upon, and a loving Mother that we should be in a prayerful and tender relationship with:

In her we contemplate what the Church already is in her mystery on her own "pilgrimage of faith," and what she will be in the homeland at the end of her journey. There, "in the glory of the Most Holy and Undivided Trinity," "in the communion of all the saints," the Church is awaited by the one she venerates as Mother of her Lord and as her own mother. In the meantime the Mother of Jesus, in the glory which she possesses in body and soul in heaven, is the image and beginning of the Church as it is to be perfected in the world to come. Likewise she shines forth on earth until the day of the Lord shall come, a sign of certain hope and comfort to the pilgrim People of God. (Cf. *Lumen Gentium* 68-69)

The divinely revealed dogma of the Assumption of Mary is an ancient Catholic teaching that was formally proclaimed by Pope Pius XII in 1950. As the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* states: "Finally the Immaculate Virgin, preserved free from all stain of original sin, when the course of her earthly life was finished, was taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord as Queen over all things, so that she might be the more fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death.' The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians…" (CCC 966).



The relics of Saint Pio of Pietrelcina (popularly known as "Padre Pio"), the saintly Franciscan priest, confessor and stigmatist of the 20th century, are coming to Saginaw! Among the relics which pilgrims may venerate are the saint's glove and cotton gauze with blood stains from his stigmata. (The stigmata, which is a mystical participation in the wounds of Christ, has been experienced by several saints in the history of the Catholic Church such as St. Francis of Assisi.) As part of this special day, Bishop Cistone will celebrate Mass at 8:30 a.m. Please note that St. Pio's bodily remains are not part of this tour of his relics. Also keep in mind that large crowds are expected from around the Midwest for this event. Special access for the elderly and those with disabilities will be provided.
