

WHAT'S THE PURPOSE?

RCIA RITUAL BOOK: paragraph 36

"It is a time of <u>evangelization:</u> faithfully and constantly the living God is proclaimed and Jesus Christ whom he has sent for the salvation of all. Thus those who are not yet Christians, their hearts opened by the Holy Spirit, may believe and be <u>freely</u> converted to the Lord and commit themselves sincerely to him."



RCIA RITUAL BOOK: paragraph 37

"From <u>evangelization</u>, completed with the help of God, come the faith and <u>initial</u> conversion that cause a person to feel called away from sin and draw into the mystery of God's love. The whole period of the precatechumenate is set aside for this evangelization, so that the <u>genuine</u> will to follow Christ and seek baptism may mature."

FORMATION

Paragraph 38:

"During this period, priests and deacons, catechists and other laypersons are to give the candidates a suitable explanation of the Gospel (see no. 42). The candidates are to receive help and attention so that with a purified and clearer intention they may cooperate with God's grace. Opportunities should be provided for them to meet families and other groups of Christians"
