- 5:30 p.m. Mass celebrated by Bishop Cistone, Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament after Mass
- 7:00 p.m. Vespers, Father Adam Maher preside and preach, followed by Benediction
Adoration continues through Sunday night

Monday October 29

- 6:30 a.m. Simple reposition followed by 6:45 a.m. Mass, 7:15 a.m. resume Adoration
- 7:00 p.m. Vespers, Deacon Stephen Blaxton preside and preach
- 8:00 p.m. Benediction and reposition

Tuesday October 30

- 6:45 a.m. Mass followed by 7:15 a.m. Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament
Adoration throughout the day
- 7:00 p.m. Vespers, Father Bill Rutkowski preside and preach, followed by
Eucharistic Procession through the Cathedral, Benediction and conclusion of 40 Hours
