There can be "competition" for resources or people involved in certain groups. There can be feelings of exclusivity – in that people who have been involved with projects for long periods of time can be unwelcoming to new members or there may be feelings of hierarchy in the ministries. "Cliques" or "silos" should not be parts of groups – especially those in church ministry.

**Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time** 

"For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each one may receive recompense, according to what he did in the body, whether good or evil." - 2 Corinthians 5:10

God has given each of us gifts. We are called to use those gifts not only for ourselves but also for others. How do you use your gifts? How would you respond when asked how you used your Godgiven gifts for others?

**Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time** 

"Then he asked them, 'Why are you terrified?

Do you not yet have faith?' " – Mark 4:40

It is easy to say that we have faith and that believe in God and his plan for us when we are in church for Sunday or Holy Day Mass or with others who are like-minded to us. But do you live your faith every day? Pray about it. Look for guidance on how you can show and live your faith daily more.

**Thirteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time** 

"...as a matter of equality your surplus at the present time should supply their needs, so that their surplus may also supply your needs, that there may be equality." -- 2 Corinthians 8:14
