June 1, 2025

Ascension of the Lord

***"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the first and the last,
the beginning and the end." - Revelations 22:13***

This familiar passage reminds us that God is in everything – every moment, every day. Thus, we should put God first in all we do – all day, every day. It is not enough to put God first just in Mass or parish activities or even in your home; God must be first in work, school, recreation and in your community and the world. Think about where God is missing in your daily life and pray for guidance on how to make Him first in areas of your life where He might be missing.

Pentecost

***"I have told you this while I am with you. The Advocate, the Holy Spirit
that the Father will send in my name – he will teach you everything
and remind you of all that I taught you." – John 14: 25-26***

Most Holy Trinity

***"But when he comes, the Spirit of truth,
he will guide you to all truth." – John 16:13***
