

Below are the steps to access the reports:


Users will need to have full access to run these reports:

1) Log in to Paycor.com as and see the new COVID-19 PPP Widget shown below. Click Learn More to go to the report download page.



2) After you click Learn More, you will see the following page below. Here you will be able to download the appropriate .CSV report whether they had 2019 payroll costs, were a new

business or new to Paycor in 2020 or are a seasonal business with 2019 wages. If you have access to more than one client in a company and have the appropriate roles to view/download this report, you will see each client you have access to on this page and this will show in ascending order by client ID.
