How to use these slides for "The Eucharistic Revival: Encountering Jesus in the Eucharist" lessons ...

- 1. To support the catechetical content of the lessons.
 - You will see references to using the artwork in each lesson. Follow those prompts.
- 2. To assist with prayer
 - It is often helpful when listening to scripture passages to have corresponding artwork on which to focus. You can use the following slides for that visual piece.
 - If you use *lectio divina*, utilize the corresponding artwork as a support to the prayer.
 - Lectio Divina process (explain before beginning)
 - 1. Project or give a printed copy of the corresponding lesson's artwork for listeners.
 - 2. Read the scripture passage (encourage attentive listening before reading).
 - 3. Pause after reading
 - 4. Ask listeners to be attentive to any word or phrase that "jumps out" at them as you read the passage a second time. (Another person could read the second time if desired.)
 - 5. Ask listeners to share any word or phrase that "jumped out" at them but ONLY the word or phrase not an explanation.
 - Listeners are sharing what the Holy Spirit gave them special "ears to hear."
 - This sharing should be open and inviting with no judgements (or negative reactions).
 - It will likely take a few times praying this way for listeners to become comfortable.
 - 6. End with a prayer that sums up the insights from the listeners.




