At a Mass to honor our senior priests Bishop Hurley said he wanted to clarify that we use the term "senior" priests rather than "retired" priests. He said we call them senior priests because they are still very active. We wouldn't be able to get by without them.

In the statistics below you will see that some of our senior priests are no longer active due to health reasons. However, most of our senior priests are very active. Some still serve as full-time pastors and others assist by being sacramental minsters or covering for priests who are away.

The Diocese of Saginaw Priests' Retirement Fund provides a pension for all our senior priests. The fund also must insure that there will be a pension for all our active priests, including those ordained just a few weeks ago.
