It is about loving someone who you might not know; someone who looks different than you; someone who has different beliefs and convictions than you. In Jesus' story, the traveler coming from Jerusalem was Jewish. The man who helped the traveler was Samaritan. Jews and Samaritans hated one another, yet the Samaritan stopped and cared for the man who was considered his enemy – and he did not expect anything in return. This is what we are called to do.

July 17, 2022

Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"...I am a minister in accordance with God's stewardship given to me to bring to completion for you the word of God." Colossians 1:25

How do others see your faith? Do they see it in your actions or in your words? Or do they only see it when you are with those from your parish or other Catholics? We are called to evangelize through our words and actions – to all; not just to those who share our faith. Ask yourself how and when others see your faith. July 24, 2022

Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

We are bombarded with messages that lead us to believe more and more that our *wants* are *needs*. God will give us what we *need*, but not always what we *want*. Jesus assures us that if we ask, God will take care of what we need. Try to focus on what you need, rather than what you want, and be grateful to God for taking care of your needs.

July 31, 2022

Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

"Take care to guard against all greed, for though one may be rich, one's life does not consist of possessions." -- Luke 12:15

This passage can be difficult in our times. Society convinces us that we are what we physically possess. There is little focus on what we "have" because of God's love for us. Take time to consider and pray about how you can be more centered on what God gives, rather than what the world gives.
